In the afternoon, discover the former Royal Palace (closed on Tuesday) now converted into a National Museum where you will admire the Pra Bang, golden Buddha who gave his name to the city, the attributes of royal power, bronze drums, etc ... You will continue with Vat Mai, a temple famous for its golden bas-reliefs telling the life of one of the reincarnations of the Buddha. It is in this monastery that the image of Prabang is displayed on the occasion of the festivals of Pimai, Lao New Year. Then Wat Sene, whose golden facade instantly catches the eye. You will also climb the 328 steps up to Mount Phousi to enjoy the panoramic view of the city at sunset. Overnight at the hotel.

Included meals: lunch and dinner.



Day 2: Luang Prabang – Pak Ou – Luang Prabang

(30km / 1 hour- 2 hours of waterway)

<u>Optional:</u> very early in the morning, around dawn, you can see the long lines of Bonzes coming out of their pagoda and walk the streets to receive food offerings from the faithful. A unique show that takes place every day of the year...

After breakfast, you will admire the splendor of **Vat Xieng Thong**, richly decorated and located at the confluence of the Nam Khan and Mekong before embarking on a local boat for a trip up the Mekong to the **sacred caves of Pak Ou**. The two caves, also called Tham Ting by the locals, are home to thousands of Buddha statues of various sizes. The caves are the subject of processions and pilgrimages during great festivities. Return to Luang Prabang and have lunch. In the afternoon, visit **Vat Visoun**, completely rebuilt according to the sketches of Delaporte following the invasion,

the looting and the destruction of the city in 1887 by the "Black Pavilions", pirates coming from the South of China. You will also visit **Vat Aham** right next door, where you will find the altar of the two main geniuses of Luang Prabang and the **Vat That** where the ashes of King Sisavang Vong are enclosed, in the great central reliquary. In the late afternoon, crossing the Mekong to climb to **Wat Chompet** and enjoy the view at sunset. Night at the hotel.

<u>SPECIAL</u>: At the end of the day, you will participate in a "Baci". Mixture of animism and Buddhism, this ceremony is specific to Laos: it aims to "summon spirits" to the one who invokes them before performing an important task or to live a major event (birth, marriage, journey, etc.)

After breakfast, visit a weavers' village as well as homemade mulberry paper workshops in Xang Khong and Wat Xieng Lek. Transfer to the airport for your next destination. End of the trip.

Day 1: Luang Prabang - Phonesavanh

(265km 7-8 hours of road)

Departure by road to Phonesavanh. On the way, small stop to visit the ethnic minority villages. Breakfast in a local restaurant. Transfer to the hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

Included meals: lunch and dinner.

Day 2 : Plain of Jars

After breakfast, drive to UXO Laos, an organization specialized in detecting and defusing bombs in the province. Local experts will explain their work and will introduce you to the detection methods used. Then, visit 3 sites of the Plain of Jars. It is one of the most mysterious places in Laos. These immense containers, which can weigh from 600 kg to one ton and whose origin remains unknown, are spread over three main sites. (1 near the city and 2 more distant south of the district of Phasay and Mount Salato). The region was also deeply affected by the many bombings during the war. Overnight at the hotel.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.



Day 3: Phonesavanh - Vientiane

After breakfast, visit the Wet market (agriculture market), then visit temples and Navang crafts. Lunch at a local restaurant, then transfer to the airport for your flight to Vientiane. End of the trip.

The Wat Sisaket temple, dating from 1818, is one of the most beautiful and important of the capital. It is the only one not to have been destroyed during the Siamese invasion and it includes traditional parts of the Laotian monastery. Wat Ho Phra Keo, where you can admire beautiful pieces that are one of the main riches of Laotian art. The Patuxai, a small triumphal arch that sits at the northern end of Lane Sang Street and visit That Luang, the country's most popular monument, is both a religious symbol and a symbol of the unity of the country. Finally, Wat Simuang, considered as the lucky temple of the city. Night at the hotel.

Day 2: Vientiane – Luang Prabang

Day 2: Vientiane – Pakse – Wat Phou – Kong Island

Breakfast, morning at the hotel, transfer to the airport for your flight to Pakse (daily flight in high season, except Monday & Thursday in low season). Arrival in Pakse, boarding a local boat for a quiet descent of 1:30 to the old capital of the South, Champassak. Transfer by road to the fabulous site of Wat Phou, classified since March 2002 as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. This temple dates from the pre-Angkorian period. Lunch at a local restaurant in Champassak. After lunch departure by road to the largest of the islands in the southern Mekong, Khong, where you will spend the night. Night at the hotel.

Day 3: Khong Island

Breakfast at the hotel. You will leave by local boat to the peaceful island of Done Khone (1h30), formerly one of the terminals of the only railway built in Laos. Walk to the Lippi Falls. Overnight in Khong

Day 4: Khong Island – Khong Papheng – Pakse (130km 1-2 hours of roads)

After breakfast at the hotel, drive towards Khone Papheng, on the Cambodian border, at the southern tip of the country to admire the largest Mekong waterfalls in Laos. Lunch at a local restaurant during visits. In the afternoon, departure by road to the village of Ban Kiet Ngong for an elephant ride of 2:30 to the site of Mount Assa and through forest and village. Then you will continue to Pakse with a stop at the exotic evening market. Night at the hotel.

Day 5: Pakse – Bolovens Highlands – Tad Lo – Tad Fan – Pakse (100km/ 2 hours of road)

Breakfast at the hotel, departure for a tour of the Bolovens Highlands with a visit to a coffee plantation and a tea plantation and falls of Tad Lo. Breakfast in a local restaurant. In the afternoon, you will continue to falls. Back on Pakse. Night at the hotel

Breakfast in a local restaurant. In the afternoon, you will visit Vat Visoun, completely rebuilt from Delaporte's sketches following the invasion, looting and destruction of the city in 1887 by the "Black Pavilions", pirates coming from the South of France. China. You will also visit Vat Aham right next door, where you will find the altar of the two main geniuses of Luang Prabang and the Vat That where are buried the ashes of King Sisavang Vong, in the great central reliquary. Night at the hotel.

In the afternoon, excursion to Kuang Si Falls, south of Luang Prabang with stops in 2 ethnic villages along the way. Possibility to swim on site (bring swimsuit and towels) and explore the surroundings. In the late afternoon, you cross the Mekong you climb the steps of Wat Chompet to have a beautiful view of Luang Prabang at sunset. Night at the hotel.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.



Day 9: Luang Prabang – Pak Ou – Luang Prabang (1-2 hours of cruise) Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the river pier near Wat Xieng Thong. Boarding a slow boat that will take you to Pak Ou, caves located at the confluence of the Mekong and Nam Ou River the two caves, also called Tham Ting by the locals, and are home to thousands of Buddha statues of different sizes. The caves are the subject of processions and pilgrimages during great festivities. Night at the hotel.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 10: Luang Prabang – Flight return

After breakfast, free time before your transfer to the airport for the return flight. End of the trip.

Day 1: Houay Xay

Arrival on the other side, passage to Laotian customs. Welcomed by our French Laotian guide, you will be transferred to the hotel. Free time for your installation. Visit this remote village in northwestern Laos and Wat Chom Khao Manilat: This prosperous monastery overlooks the city and the river. Built in 1880, the Shan style teak temple houses a 1485 stele donated by a former prince of Chiang Khong. Villages of the Lanetene ethnic groups in the surrounding villages. Overnight at the hotel.

Included meals: lunch and dinner.

Day 2: Visit Houei Xay

You will go west to the site of Souvanakhounkham, on the border of Thailand and Burma. Recently accessible to visitors, at the entrance of the famous Golden Triangle, Souvanakhounkham can only be reached after a short walk through the rice fields, in a green and unspoilt area. On the site, you will visit the old Wat and its big statue of Buddha, and you will admire interesting reliefs going back, essentially, to the time of King Setthathirath (sixteenth century). Lunch. Return to Ban Hui Xay in the afternoon. Overnight at Houei Xay.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.



Day 3: Houei Xay – Pakbeng (7-8 heures of cruises)

After breakfast, board a private local boat with a roof. The descent of the Mekong at a slow and relaxing pace will allow you to take some pictures and admire the landscape where many remote villages of the world seem to live peacefully along the river nourished. In the late afternoon, arrival and installation at Pakbeng Lodge. Overnight at Pakbeng Lodge.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.



Day 4: Pakbeng – Elephant ride

After breakfast, you will go to elephant camp for an elephant ride:

- You will observe the elephant bath from one of the two footbridges

- After swimming, you will ride on the elephants, start of the ride. The walk begins with the river surrounded by a bamboo plantation. The path then goes into the forest. Then, the horizon emerges, offering an exceptional point of view on the parades. At the bend of the road, we can see the Mekong below. Then, the elephants cross a H'Mong village. Finally, it's back to camp.

Then, free time. Overnight at Pakbeng Lodge.

Day 5: Pakbeng – Kamu Lodge

After breakfast, board a boat to Kamu Lodge. The Kamu Lodge is made up of 20 tents, each covered with a thatched roof, to blend in with the natural environment and protect them from the elements, while being harmoniously decorated in the local style. Each tent is equipped with bamboo and wooden furniture. Each bathroom has hot water thanks to a solar shower system. Arrival at Kamu Lodge, welcome drink. Overnight at Kamu Lodge



Day 6: Kamu Lodge – Pak Ou – Luang Prabang

After breakfast, you can participate in optional activities:

- Demonstration (with possible participation) of rice cultivation and transplanting in the rice fields bordering the Lodge.

- Gold panning in the Mekong (January to June). Everything you find will be yours!
- Walk in the forest with information on traditional medicinal plants.
- Trekking to a magnificent waterfall 15 m high (2 hours of walking and boating).
- Net fishing in the Mekong with tasting of catch!
- Discovery of a minority village and meeting with its inhabitants.
- Crossbow shooting.

After you are rested, departure by boat for Luang Prabang in the afternoon. Stop en route to the Pak Ou caves. Located 2 hours upstream from Luang Prabang, the Pak Ou Caves are home to several hundred lacquered gold Buddha statues crammed into two impressive cliff sites. Their size varies from a few centimeters to the size of a human being. The caves are also an important destination for pilgrimages. Once in Luang Prabang, transfer to your hotel. Overnight in Luang Prabang.



Day 7 : Luang Prabang

<u>Optional:</u> very early in the morning, around dawn, you can see the long lines of Bonzes coming out of their pagoda and walk the streets to receive food offerings from the faithful. A unique show that takes place every day of the year ...

After breakfast, discover the former Royal Palace, today converted into a National Museum where you will admire the Pra Bang, the attributes of royal power, bronze drums, etc ... You will continue with the Wat Mai temple known for its gilded bas-reliefs counting the life of one of the reincarnations of the Buddha and you will admire the splendor of Vat Xieng Thong, richly decorated and located at the confluence of the Nam Khan and Mekong. Lunch at the local restaurant. Visit Wat Than Luang, then Vat Visoun, entirely rebuilt from Delaporte's sketches following the invasion, looting and destruction of the city in 1887 by the "Black Pavilions", pirates from southern China. You will also visit Vat Aham right next door, where is the altar of the two main geniuses of Luang Prabang. Visit the evening Hmong market where you will find ethnic handicrafts. *Night at the hotel.*

SPÉCIAL: At the end of the day, you will participate in a "Baci". Mixture of animism and Buddhism, this ceremony is specific to Laos: it aims to "call minds" to the one who invokes them before performing an important task or to live a major event (birth, marriage, journey, etc.) (The Baci ceremony only, no traditional dance).

Included meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.



Day 8: Luang Prabang – Kuang Si – Flight for Vientiane (35km/ 45 minutes of road)

Return to Luang Prabang in the afternoon to take the flight to Vientiane (QV104 1750-1830). On arrival in Vientiane, welcome by your local guide and transfer to your hotel. Night at the hotel.

Wat Ho Phra Keo, where you can admire beautiful pieces that are one of the main riches of Laotian art, Wat Simuang, considered the lucky temple of the city. The Patuxai, a small triumphal arch that sits at the northern end of Lane Sang Street and visit That Luang, the country's most popular monument, is both a religious symbol and a symbol of the unity of the country. In the afternoon, visit the Buddha Park where you can walk, see the Hindu and Buddhist representations of BUDDHA. Then visit the ethnic park. Night at the hotel.

Day 10: Vientiane – Flight for Pakse – Wat Phou – Khong Island

Breakfast at the hotel, transfer to the airport for your flight to Pakse (QV512 0630- 0745 / possible flight on Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday and Sunday). Arrival in Pakse, embarkation in a local boat for a quiet descent of 1h30 min to the old capital of the South, Champassak. Transfer by road to the fabulous site of Wat Phou, classified since March 2002 as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. This temple dates from the pre-Angkorian period. After lunch departure by road to the largest of the islands in the southern Mekong, Khong, where you will spend the night. Night at the hotel.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 11: Khong Island – Area of 4000 islands

After breakfast, departure by motor canoe for a cruise through the labyrinth of waterways formed by the tropical paradise of Siphandone, "4000 Islands". During the rainy season, the Mekong reaches a width of 14 km; when the waters recede, they leave behind a myriad of islands and islets. Visit the islands of Deth and Som to discover the way of life of local fishermen. Arrival on the island of Khone. Discovery of the colonial remains of the island of Khone and continuation to the falls of Liphi, where lives a colony of freshwater dolphins. Overnight at Khong Island.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.



Day 12: Khong Island – Tadlo

Breakfast at the hotel. Road back to Tadlo. Located in the extreme north-east of the Bolovens plateau, abundant with trees, industry like tea, coffee, cardamom, vegetables and fruits. On the plateau, you can also visit the villages of ethnic minorities: Alak, Lawe, Katu, Ya Heuneand a beautiful eco-tourism site at Pha Xuam. Arrival at Tad Lo, installation in a bungalow, located at the edge of the Sexet river in the forest. Overnight at Tad Lo Lodge

Included meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.



Day 13: Tad Lo – Tad Yuang – Pakse – Flight for Luang Prabang (100km/1-2 hours of road)

Breakfast at the hotel, departure to Tad Yuang Falls. You will continue to Pakse for the flight to Luang Prabang. Meet at Luang Prabang Airport and transfer to the hotel for installation. Dinner free. Night at the hotel.

Day 3 : Luang Prabang - Kuang Si - Luang Prabang (35km /45 minutes of road)

Continue with Vat Mai, a temple renowned for its gilded bas-reliefs and the life of one of the reincarnations of the Buddha. It is in this monastery that the image of Prabang is displayed on the occasion of the Pimai, Lao New Year celebrations. Then the Wat Sene, whose golden facade instantly catches the eye, finally you will admire the splendor of Vat Xieng Thong, richly decorated and located at the confluence of the Nam Khan and Mekong. After lunch, excursion to the falls of Kuang Si. Stop in two ethnic villages on the way. Possibility to swim on site (bring swimsuit and towel). Night at the hotel.

Pak ou- Oudomxay (118km/ 4-5 hours of road)

Day 7: Luang Nam Tha – Oudomxay – Nong Khiow (210km /4-5 hours of roads)


