In many minds, Thailand rhymes with exoticism, dream holidays, paradise beaches in the south, lush jungle and elephant rides ... But Thailand is also Bangkok, a hyperactive and ever-growing city, and it is also the north with its mountain tribes and temples. All these different facets make Thailand a fascinating country, between modernity and tradition, beaches and mountains, culture and relaxation.

Thailand, formerly known as the Kingdom of Siam, is bordered in the west and northwest by Burma, in the south by Malaysia, in the east by Cambodia and in the northeast by Laos. The country is bordered by two seas: the China Sea and the Andaman Sea.







The northern part of the country is covered with karst mountains and forests, and many ethnic minorities live there; the northeast is the least frequented area for travellers, it is mainly made up of arid plateaus. The centre of the country is a large, densely populated fertile basin, while the south is characterized by its many beaches and paradise islands.

Day 1: Arrival in Bangkok

Arrival in Bangkok. Welcome by your guide and transfer to the hotel. Free afternoon. Overnight and dinner at your hotel.

Included meal: dinner

<u>Note</u>: Check-in at the hotel starts at 2.00pm. If you arrive earlier the morning, we will offer you an available room as soon as you arrive. Just let us know before!



Day 2: Bangkok – Damnoen Saduak – Bangkok

Departure to visit the very picturesque **floating market of Damoen Saduak** on board of motorized canoes. Back to Bangkok. Visit of the Grand Palace, the temple of the **Emerald and Reclining Buddha**. Dinner entertained by traditional dances. Overnight at your hotel.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 3: Bangkok - Ayuthaya - Phitsanulok

Departure to Ayuthaya. Along the way, visit of the Summer's Palace of Bang Pa In. In Ayuthaya, visit of the remains of this former capital: **Wat Yaï Tchaïmonkol and Wat Monkolbophit**. Visit

of the remains. Khmers of **Lopburi**: **Prang Samyod and San Prakan (Monkeys temple)**. Road to Phitsanulok. Overnight at your hotel.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 4: Phitsanulok - Sukhothai - Chiang Rai

Visit of the city and of the **Wat Prabouddhajinaraj** temple sheltering a very pretty statue of Buddha dating from the 13th century. In Sukhothaï, visit of the historic park: **Wat Mahatat, Wat Srasri, and Wat Trapung Nguern**. Road to Chiang Rai, have a break at the Phayao lake and in the pineapple fields where you will be able to taste fresh fruits. Overnight at your hotel.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 5: Chiang Rai - Golden triangle - Chiang Mai

Departure for an encounters day and unknown feelings at the discovery of the Yaos and Akhas mountainous tribes in Maechan. You will go on towards the Golden triangle and the Mekong, natural boundary between Thailand, Laos and Myanmar. Stroll in motorized canoe on the Kok river until the Karens village. Road towards Chiang Mai. Overnight at your hotel.



Day 6 : Chiang Mai

Visit the **Doi Suthep temple**. Visit of the **crafts villages**: silk, lacquer, parasols, silverware, precious stones. **Kantoke dinner followed by a traditional northern dances show**. Overnight at your hotel.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 7 : Chiang Mai – Night train to Bangkok

Visit of an **elephants dressing camp** where you will attend at the training and bathe of the elephants. Visiting a **farm with orchids**. **Lunch**. **Overnight in a sleeper train to Bangkok, an opportunity of many exchanges with the Thai population**.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 8: Bangkok – flight to Mandalay – visit of the city

Breakfast at the hotel, transfer at the airport. Flight to Mandalay. At your morning arrival at Mandalay's international airport, our experienced driver will welcome and transfer you to your hotel. After the check-in at the hotel, you will be brought to the pier for a boat stroll until Migun,

which is located at 11 km away above Mandalay on the West shore of the Ayeyarwaddy. Discovery of the Mingun's unfinished pagoda and the Myatheindan's pagoda and a gigantic bell of 90 tons, the largest of the world which is still intact. The 45 minute cruise is a very good way to discover the daily life around the Ayeyarwaddy. Back to Mandalay. In the evening, you will be transported until Mandalay's hill (230 meters high) from where you are able to observe a wonderful sunset on the town. Back to Mandalay.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 9: Mandalay - Sagain - Ava

Breakfast at the hotel. Vistit of the main sites of Sagain. Kaung Hmu Daw pagoda: built in 1636 by the Thalon king in order to commemorate the establishment of Inwa as the new capital of Myanmar. Discovery of the very pretty hill of Sagain whose flanks are endowed with numerous pagodas and monasteries. It is probably the heart of the Buddhist culture within Myanmar of today. Visit of the Soon Oo Pon Nya Shin pagoda (built in 1312) as well as the U Min Tonzeh, U Min Chaukzeh and Min Koezeh pagodas. Afternoon's visits program: First of all you are going to embark on board of a small boat on the Ayeyarwarddy. The tour begins with the monastery of Maha Augmye Bonzan: the building made of bricks and stucco built by Nanmadaw Me Nu, the Queen of Bagyidaw in 1822, locating on the south shore of the Ayeyarwaddy (north of Inwa). Then, Bagaya Kyang (60 feet tall and 9 of circumference) and Nanmyint Hmyawzin (Nanmyint's point of view). You won't be able to enjoy the panoramic view because its ascent is not allowed at this period. Finally you will cross through the U Bein bridge and enjoy a wonderful sunset. Overnight at the hotel in Mandalay.



Day 10 : Mandalay - Monywa

Breakfast at the hotel. Beginning of the road to Monywa (140 km – 4 hours).

In the afternoon, you will visit the Thanboddhay pagoda which is located at aproximately 20 kilometers away from Monywa. Inside, you will be able to observe hundred of Buddha's representation (more than 500,000) which decorate each wall, arch and niche. The building presents also interesting jakata bas-reliefs. Overnight at the hotel in Monywa.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 11 : Monywa – Pakokku – Bagan

Breakfast at the hotel. The morning, road to Pakkoku. It is a small authentic village known in the tobacco business sector but also for its workshops of silk manufacture. The stroll along the river will allow you to discover the daily life of the local population. Then, visit of the local market during which you will discover a true traditional outdoors market along with very diversified products in sales such as fresh fruits and vegetables, textiles, craft objects and many other things. You will discover a true traditional open-air market with very diverse products in sales such as fresh fruits and vegetables, textiles, handicrafts and much more. If the timetables allow it, we will continue the visits with Thanaka's seller, the cigar factory, the slippers manufacture workshop as well as a wood engraving workshop. You will then enjoy a private cruise on the Ayeyarwaddy until Bagan (around 3 hours). At your arrival at Bagan you will be transferred at your hotel to enjoy the remaining of the day as you want to. Overnight at the hotel in Bagan.



Day 12: Bagan - Visit day in Bagan

Breakfast at the hotel. Visits: Nyaung Oo market, Shwezigon pagoda: it is in fact a prototype of the future stupas which will be built in Myanmar. Then, Kyansittha and the Kandawplin pagoda: on the road between Nyaung and New Bagan, near the architecture museum, is located this 2 floors temple which is one of the largest and imposing of Bagan. Then the Thatbyinnyu pagoda: built in 1144 by Alaungsithu, it is the highest temple of Bagan. It is made of 4 floors of a with a height of 207 feet. Finally, visit the Shwegugyi Pagoda and the Tharabar gate. This is the best preserved remains of the wall of the 9th century but also the only door still standing today. It has been built by Pyinbya Min, the first king of Bagan. Overnight at the hotel in Bagan.

Included meals : breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 13: Bagan - Heho - Inle lake

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer at Bagan's airport for your flight to Heho. At your arrival at Heho's airport, you will be directly lead to Inle lake. If the timetabes match, you will be able to visit the market of Mine Thauk as well as Phaung Daw Oo floating market where you will be able to see many hill's tribes inhabitants purchasing and selling local products but also discover traditional fishing technics as well as the villagers' daily life on the lake. Afternoon's visits: Phaungdaw pagoda, beautiful floating gardens, Nga Phe Chaung monastery, workshops for goldsmiths, a traditional silk factory, a forge and a cigar factory. Overnight at the hotel at Inle lake.



Day 14: Inle lake - Indein - Inle lake

After breakfast, you will leave on a cruise towards Indaing (on the West shore of the lake). The stroll will allow you to observe farmers who cultivate their fields. This cruise is one of the most interesting and most beautiful to make on the Inle lake. The beauty of the sunset will enchant you. Overnight at the Inle lake.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 15: Inle lake - Sagar visit - Inle lake

Breakfast at the hotel. Beginning of the excursion in Sankar (Sagar) and Thakong in motorized boat via Nampan. The journey will last aproximately 2 hours. Visit of Kyauk Daing market, a Shan village which principally lives of the business of its potteries. During your stroll by foot in the village of Sankar, you will be able to observe traditional rice mills that actually work thanks to harnesses of oxen and discover the culture and lifestyle of the Pa-O and Intha ethnic groups around Sankar and Hmawbi. Then, excursion on the lake to admire the beautiful scenery. Overnight at the hotel at Inle lake.



Day 16: Inle lake - Yangon

After breakfast, transfer at the airport. Back to Yangon through a domestic flight. Arrival in Yangon and check-in at the hotel. If you wish it, you will be able to go shopping at the Bogyoke market (closed on Monday). It is an ideal place to buy traditional and untraditionnal craft objects as well as small antiquities, jewelry items or other memories. In the evening, enjoy a beautiful sunset from the Shwedagon pagoda and its bazaar. The beautiful and imposing Shwedagon pagoda (100 meters tall) and one of the wonders of the world. It has been built 2 500 years ago and shelters Buddha's relics. It is a place of devotion and meditation. Overnight at hotel in Yangon.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 17: Yangon visit

Breakfast at the hotel. Start the visit of Yangon which will include Sule's pagoda. According to the legend, it would be 2000 year old and its central stoupa would contain a hair of Buddha. During a walking tour you will discover the unique charm of Yangon with its colonial architecture which appears in places such as the Town Hall or the High Court of Justice. In the evening, visit of the Botahtaung pagoda (which contains also relics of Buddha), Mahabandoola's park along with former buildings of colonial style. You will be able to discover Yangon's pier. Overnight at the hotel in Yangon.



Day 18: Yangon - Return flight

After breakfast, transfer to the airport / flight to Bangkok.

Day 1: Arrival in Bangkok

Arrival in Bangkok. Welcome at the airport and transfer at the hotel to rest.

Included meal: no meal



Day 2: Bangkok – Khorat – Burinam – Surin

Visit of the Prasat Phimai as well as the archaeological museum of Phimai. Go on towards Nagrong's district and visit of the majestic Prasat Khao Phanom Rung (also a Khmer temple built in the 12th century) located at the top of a volcano. Then you will go to Surin, high-place of the same name's province, famous for its Khmer ruins.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 3: Surin - Ubon Rachathani - Khong Jiam

Departure to Sikhoraphum and visit of the Khmer temple built in bricks and sandstone. Go on to Si Saket and visit of the Sra Kamphaeng Yai temple. Discovery of the majestic Preah Vihear

located at the edge of a cliff on the Cambodian side (no visa required). Continue of the road towards Khong Jiam, a city situated at the Mekong edge.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 4: Khong Jiam

After breakfast, you will visit the historical park of Pha Taem having a view on the Mekong river. The ancient paintings located here have between 5 000 and 7 000 years old, and represent giant fishs, elephants and others.

Included meals : breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 5: Khong Jiam – Mukdahan – Nakhon Phanom

Road to Mukdahan. Free time at the Indochina's market. Discovery of the Wat Phra That Phanom. Arrival at the end of the afternoon at Nakhon Phanom.



Day 6: Nakhon Phanom

In the morning, start your day with a stroll in the center of the city near the former clock's tower. The local population says that it was a gift from Ho Chi Minh president back in the 1950s. Continue to visit the the old house of Ho Chi Minh. There is a large population of Vietnamese origin in Nakhon Phanom. You will be making a stroll by feet to the city center of Nakorn Phanom with your guide and visit the Wat Yai Pra before making a boat stroll on the Mekong to see beautiful landscapes of Laos and Thailand. Back to your hotel and take a time for your own leisure and relaxing.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 7: Nakhon - Sakon Nakhorn - Udon Thani

Road towards Sakon Nakhorn located at the edge of Nong Harn lake. Visit of the Wat Phra That Choeng Chum followed by the Phra That Narai Cheng Weng, a site of Khmer inspiration. Continue to Baan Chiang, archaeological site of an ancient civilization of more than 3000 years (classified at the UNESCO). Arrival in Udon Thani in the late afternoon.



Day 8: Udon Thani – Loei - Phitsanulok

Departure to Phu Phra Bat, a historic park which has been the site of ancient prehistoric civilizations. Small hiking in the park which is located in a forest. Continue to Loei. Arrival at the end of the afternoon in Phitsanulok.

Included meals : breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 9: Phitsanulok - Sukhothai - Lampang

Visit of the Wat Phra Sri Rattana Ma and the Buddha Chinaraj. Discovery of the center of manufacture of main statues of Buddha according to the traditionnal method lost wax. Drive to Sukhotai Historical Park. Visit Wat Mahathat and Wat Sri Chum. Depart for Lampang to visit Wat Phra Lampang Luang.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 10: Lampang - Phayao - Chiang Rai

Visit of Baan Saonak, ancient maison in traditional wood built in 1895. Go on with short breaks along the way to discover a pineapple field, then the Phayao lake which is the largest fishing center in northern Thailand. Arrival in Chiang Rai. Visit of a reconstituted village looking like the different ethnicities of the north: Akkhas, Yao, Lahu. Continue the road towards the famous Golden Triangle. Arrival in Chaing Saen. Discovery of the opium museum. Back to Chiang Ra.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 11: Chiang Rai - Chiang Mai

Discovery of Wat Phra Keo. Stroll on the market and then excursion in canoe on the Kok river to join the tribe of Tibeto-Burman origin. Go on towards Chiang Mai with a break along the way to discover a hot water source.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 12 : Chiang Mai – Mok Fah waterfall – Karen village

At 7.00am, you will leave from your hotel to Chiang Mai for a first step at the **local market of Mae Malai**. Meeting with flowers mercants, fruits and vegetables. Go on to the Mok Fha falls where you will be able to enjoy of a moment of relaxation and bathe. Lunch at Baan Pang Lun. Road towards the **Shan village of Baan Mae Sae** (2 hour and 30 minutes hiking) towards Karen village of Baan Mae Jok. Meeting and exchanges with the inhabitants. Dinner and overnight at the homestay (summary comfort).

Included meals : breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 13: Karen village – Lahu Akha village

After having breakfast at the departure village for a 3 hour hiking towards the elephants camp. Lunch served at the camp. Departure for a 1 hour and 30 minutes stroll on elephant's back through the trails and streams of the village of the White Karen. Arrival at the Bann Pang Khao Lam village. Dinner and overnight at the village (summary comfort).

Included meals : breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 14: Karen village – Lahu Akha village

In the morning, you will make a 3 hour bamboo rafting on the Mae Tang river. Lunch in a lodge. Continue with a 2 hour trek towards a village of the Akha tribe. Dinner and overnight at the village.

Included meals : breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 15 : Lahu Akha village - Shan village - Chiang Mai

After breakfast, 1 hour hiking towards a Shan village. Lunch at the village and then transfer in a local truck to Chiang Mai until your hotel. Dinner and overnight.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 16: Chiang Mai – Chiang Khong – Hueixay

From Chiang Khong, take a car to Hueixay – to obtain the Laos' visa through this post. Arrival in Houeixay. Hosted by our english-speaking Laotian guide, you are transferred to the hotel. Free time for your installation. Lunch served in a local restaurant. Visit this isolated village at the northwest of Laos and Wat ChomKhao Manilat: this prosperous monastery overlooks the city and the river. Built in 1880, the teak temple, shan style, shelters a stele dating from 1485 offered by an ancient prince of Chiang Khong. Visit of the Lantern ethnicity villages in the surrounding villages. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 17: Hueixay - Cruise on the Mekong - Pakbeng

You will embark on a junk for a cruise on the Mekong river. Have a break to visit the ethnic minorities villages: Hmong, Yao and Khmu. Visit of the local market in Pakheng. Lunch along the way. Dinner and overnight in Pakheng.



Day 18: Pakbeng - Pak Ou - Luang Prabang

We will walk around the Mekong river, which gives also a good review of the peaceful countryside as well as an interesting visit to the mysterious caverns of Pak Ou, stuffed of the thousands gold-lacquered Buddha statues and various shapes and sizes. Along the way, we stop at the village of Ban Xang Hai, where they make the local rice wine. Upon arrival in Luang Prabang, transfer to Ancient Luang Prabang hotel. Overnight in Luang Prabang.

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 19: Luang Prabang – Visit of the city

Capital of the Lane Xang kingdom until the middle of the 15th century, Luang Prabang will amaze you with its many temples, its enchanting setting on the banks of the Mekong River, its peaceful life pace, its colonial style buildings, or the Phousi Mount. This visit begins by the discovering of the Royal Palace, today reconverted into a National Museum where you will admira the Pra Bang, Golden buddha who has given its name to the city, the attributes of the royal power, bronze drums etc. Go on with the Vat Mai, temple reputated for its golden bas-reliefs counting the life of one of the Buddha's reincarnations. It is in this monastery that is exposed the picture of Prabang at the occasion of the Pimai's festivities, Lao new year's eve. Then the Vat Sene, whose golden facade instantly attracts attention, finally we are going to admire the splendor of the Vat Xieng Thong, richly ornamented and situated at the confluence of the Nam Khan and the Mekong. Breakfast in a local restaurant. The afternoon, you will visit the Vat Visoun, perfectly rebuilt according to the sketches of Delaporte following the invasion, the looting and

destruction of the city in 1887 by the "Pavilions Noirs", pirates coming from the South of China. We are also visiting the **Vat Aham** just next to, where is located the altar of the two principal spirits of Luang Prabang and the **Vat That**, where the ashes of King Sisavang Vong are enclosed in the great central reliquary. *Dinner in a local restaurant. Overnight at the hotel*.

<u>Special</u>: At the end of the day, you will participate in a "Baci". Mix of animism and Buddhism, this ceremony is specific to Laos: it is made to "recall its spirits" to the one who invokes it before accomplishing an important task or living a major event (birth, wedding, travel etc.) (**Only the ceremony, no traditional dance**).

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 20 : Luang Prabang - Kuang Si falls

<u>Optional</u>: very early in the morning, at sunrise, observe the long lines of Bonzes which come out of their pagoda and walk in the streets to receive food offerings from the faithfuls. A unique show which takes places every day of the year.

After breakfast, excursion to the **Kuang Si falls**. Have a break in two ethnic villages along the way. Possibility of bathing on site (bring a swimsuit and a towel). Then we will climb trying to reach out the summit for a pleasant exploration of the sacred golden stupa as well as the magnificent sunset over the city and the Mekong. From here, we will explore the night market where you will be able to find a nice collection of handmade textiles by local and mountain tribes living around Luang Prabang. Overnight at hotel in Luang Prabang. Have a dinner in a local restaurant and overnight in Luang Prabang.



Day 21: Luang Prabang - Stroll on an elephant's back

Half-day experience on an elephant's back. After breakfast, go to the elephant's park and elephant's village, located at 15 km away in the south of the city in the tropical forest. Here, one hour stroll on elephants' back through the beautiful scenery and the river's valley of Nam Khane. Then you will embark on a boat towards Tad Sae's fall. There, you will be able to relax for a while in the freshness of the waterfalls. Picpic lunch at the edge of the river. Back to the elephant's village, then transfer to Luang Prabang. Free afternoon (no service required).

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner



Day 22: Luang Prabang - Return flight

After breakfast, visit of a weavers village as well as manufacturing craft workshops of mulberry paper in **Xang Khong** and **Wat Xieng Lek**. Transfer at the airport to your next destination.

Arrival in Bangkok, welcome with flowered guirlands. Transfer and installation at the Aetas Lumpini 4* hotel. Free time. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 2: Bangkok - Amphawa

Meeting with your french speaking guide at your hotel in Bangkok, then departure to a very friendly small town located at 80 km away in southern Bangkok: Amphawa. Have a first break along to way to visit one of the most interesting temples of all the region: the Wat Bang Kung. Built in the 17th century, it especially shelters a small chapel covered with, in a main part, huge nanyan fig trees (also known under the name of "Banyan Tree"). You will then go on to the craft center of « Benjarong », where ceramic objects are finely and richly handmade decored (and formerly dedicated exclusively to kings). Not only reputated by their scratchs resistency, their beautiful colors do not change very much through time. You will learn more here on the different manufacturing techniques and see its craftsmen working. Then have a lunch in a local restaurant, located near a river. Then arrival in Amphawa, small town full of charm and surrounded by small water streams, and check-in at the Baan Amphawa Resort hotel located at the edge of the Mae Klong river (your hotel for the night). At the afternoon's program: longtailed boat ride in the village canals offering a very special landscape. Here, whether you are in love with authentic atmosphere or amateur photographers, you will love the scenery that you find while walking through: coconut groves, orchards, wooden houses on stilts, small bridges, merchants of all kinds and their small boats, or bathers. Then go back to the hotel. In the
